
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Goals	Challenge of Practice	Success Criteria
To improve children’s ability to self-regulate to support their wellbeing at preschool	If we engage in a pedagogical inquiry with a focus on building children’s ability to self-regulate, we will intentionally model strategies throughout the learning environment to support children’s wellbeing.
